Passage: Acts 4:32 – 5:11

Main Point: We are generous with others because God lovingly and generously gives us His son to save us.

- We should be generous and willing to give to others.
- We do this as a testimony of our faith.
- Being generous is a response from our heart, it's not just about the act.

Craft: Make a generosity jar!

Things you need:

- A glass/plastic jar
- Paddle-pop sticks (wider ones will be easier to use than thin ones)
- Materials for decoration (e.g. pens/markers, stickers, ribbons/string)

What to do:

- Label the jar "Generosity Jar" (you can use a sticky label for this, or write it on the jar with permanent marker)
- Decorate the jar however you like (e.g. stickers, tying a ribbon around the top)
- On each paddle-pop stick, write 1 way you can be generous. This can be something like "share toys with my little sister/brother", "being kind when playing with friends", "helping my mum with chores".
- Remember to try and do some of the things you've written on the paddle-pop sticks!
